

The Peoples Rights

The Constitution of the United States When Ratified on December 15, 1791,

Created a new political power in the world,

The***Sovereign Individual.**

All men are by nature free and independent, and have certain inalienable rights **among which are those of enjoying and defending** life and liberty: acquiring, possessing and protecting property: and pursuing and obtaining safety and happiness.

The whole debate is not about what *Rights the *GOVERNMENT thinks we **have, but rather our willingness to defend the Rights we KNOW we have.** Part of that process is educating people about their Rights and about the Constitution. Once enough people realize that the government is passing laws that it has NO authority or jurisdiction to pass, then the government itself loses legitimacy.

Conversely, if you allow any unit of government to disinherit you of a Right, then **you suggest that the action is legitimate, then the battle changes from** one of Rights, to one of pleading with the government to "allow" you to subsist. Once you "admit" that the government can deprive you of a Right, the only thing left to debate is which Rights they will allow you to possess. We must keep in our minds that any law, ordinance, administrative rule, executive order or any guise of law that is not in full agreement with the Constitution is Unconstitutional and as no law at all. **Any action** performed by an agent of government that is unconstitutional is illegal, and while performing that action the person ceases to be an agent of government or to have any official status, regardless of what trappings of office or color of law he **may project.** It is also almost certainly a deprivation of the civil rights of someone, and therefore also a violation of one or more of the constitutional criminal laws against doing so. Also the incroachment on the people's rights and the *usurpation of their powers by private interest lobby groups (MTA, MAC, COG, UN, etc.), **through their** lobbying efforts and influence should be alarming to all citizens.

Always remember **that the people, the source of all political power, are responsible** for instructing Federal, State and Local governments and to restrict their governmental powers to limitations defined in the Constitution.

The Constitution of the United States of America Amendment XIV, (1868) No State shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities **of citizens of the United States; nor shall any State deprive** any person of life, liberty or property without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws.

*Sovereign Individual: Free self-governed being or soul.

*Rights: **Privileges bestowed to a people by their Creator; guaranteed against violation by governments:** That law which God, the sovereign of the universe, has prescribed to all men.

***Government: always subservient to "the People" and thus a society based upon the "sovereign**

individual"; consists of those persons to whom certain powers held **by the sovereign**

individuals in common are delegated, to act as agents for those **sovereign individuals, exercising only such powers as are delegated to them, and according to their instructions.**

*Usurpation: The exercise of power not delegated.
